

# RICHARD AND JANET ADAMS v. AMANDA BOLSAR (2010 CV 9952)

On August 1, 2009, Plaintiff Richard Adams was traveling west on Hersheypark Drive and was approaching the intersection of Hersheypark Drive and Laudermilch Road. Janet Adams was a front seat passenger in her husband's vehicle. At the same time, Defendant was traveling east on Hersheypark Drive and turned left onto Laudermilch Road into the path of the Plaintiffs' vehicle, causing the collision. Injuries were sustained.

# COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA v. DOUGLAS SNELL (4275 CR 2009)

The jury found the defendant not guilty of committing sex crimes against his girlfriend's daughter, including rape, aggravated indecent assault, indecent assault, unlawful contact and corruption of minors. The defense had argued the allegations were false.

Prior to trial, the court granted the defendant's motion to admit a 2006 allegation of sexual assault involving the same child holding that admission of such evidence did not implicate the Rape Shield Law and that furthermore, the evidence was relevant and not overly prejudicial. In the 2006 case, the alleged victim's father claimed that the child's ten-year-old uncle (the mother's brother, with whom she lived) had sexually abused her. That allegation was investigated and the case closed as unfounded. After that incident, the child's father sought primary custody citing it was in the best interests of the child to live with him due to the dangerous conditions present at the mother's home. Around that time, defendant began to reside with the victim and her mother. After the current allegations, the child's father obtained primary physical custody and the child lived with him and the paternal grandmother.

The prior sexual assault claim was relevant to show that because defendant was aware of this allegation, knew that it had been brought to the attention of police by the child's father, knew of the custody battle between the child's parents and of the past use by the father of that sexual assault allegation, defendant claimed he never left himself alone with the child throughout the entire time he has lived with her.

The defense also argued her "false" memory of having been sexually touched by the defendant was the result of various factors, such as the result of child being prompted by paternal grandmother and improper suggestive interviewing of the child at the Children's Resource Center, to the point that the child now actually believed she had been sexually assaulted. In addition, the child's testimony at trial was inconsistent with her prior statements regarding what had occurred.
