As a criminal defense attorney, Lenora made trouble for those unscrupulous witnesses who had issues with the truth, with the government when a client's Constitutional rights were compromised or when she believed a politician wasn't looking out for the citizens she represented. In reality, what we do as attorneys often involves making trouble for those who run afoul of the law.

In Lenora's honor and in her memory, be a troublemaker for someone this month. You, like Lenora, will make our community a better place.


### **PRO BONO EXPUNGEMENT CLINIC**




## **NATURALIZATION CEREMONY NOVEMBER 7, 2016**
