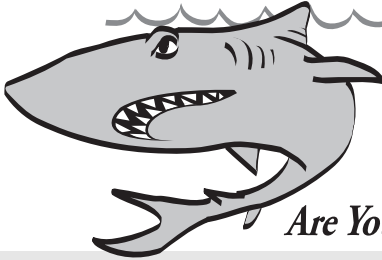

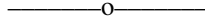

As a service to members of the *Dauphin County Bar Association*, a brief synopsis of verdicts from each civil trial term will be printed.

Summary of Verdicts from the April 2007 Civil Jury Term.

The Judges have completed the April 2007 civil jury term. A total of seven cases reached verdict and two cases settled after the commencement of trial. The summaries are as follows:

JOHN KALINAY and TERESA KALINAY v. LARRY L. SOLLENBERGER, M.D., ANDREW J. RICHARDS, M.D., BRIAN S. DELONG, M.D. and SOLLENBERGER COLON & RECTAL SURGERY, INC. (1513 CV 2001)

In April 1999, plaintiff John Kalinay was examined by Dr. Sollenberger and was diagnosed with a prolapsed posterior internal hemorrhoid. Plaintiff underwent a simple banding procedure. Dr. Sollenberger did not advise or inform the plaintiff of the possibility he might get sepsis (a rare occurrence) from this procedure. On April 9, 1999, plaintiff telephoned Sollenberger Colon & Rectal Surgery, per his post care instructions and complained of rectal pain, pressure and difficulty urinating, all signs of post banding infection. Plaintiff was advised to have a warm bath and go to an emergency room for catheter insertion if the problem persisted. The problem worsened and he went to Hershey Medical Center's Emergency Room on April 10, 1999 and a catheter was inserted. His condition did not improve and he returned to the emergency room for removal of the catheter. Plaintiff was seen by Defendant Delong on April 11, 1999 and was admitted to Harrisburg Hospital. Intravenous antibiotics were administered but his condition worsened and he was transferred to ICU with sepsis/toxic shock syndrome. The family insisted that he be transferred to Hershey Medical Center. Dr. Richards said "we don't send our dirty laundry to Hershey." The family attempted to hand him a downloaded procedure to treat the defendant's condition (suggested by plaintiff's employer, a doctor) but the doctor refused to look at anything obtained off the internet. The family could not transfer the defendant to Hershey Medical Center because he was in an unstable condition due to the placement of a respirator as he could no longer breathe himself. The next day he was taken to Hershey Medical Center on April 17, 1999 where he underwent immediate surgeries including the procedure on the "internet" download previously rejected by Dr. Richards, a colostomy to treat a massive amount of infection, necrosis and pulmonary failure. He remained hospitalized until May 14, 1999 and has had follow-up surgeries. At the time of his treatment, Plaintiff was 34 years old, employed as an exercise physiologist/staff nurse and was in extremely good health prior to his sepsis and an active biker and runner. He can no longer engage in biking and running. Plaintiff alleged that the defendants failed to advise him of the risks of the procedure and were negligent for failing to examine him immediately upon his first complaints and failing to fully and aggressively treat his infection following the April 11, 1999 admission. The jury found no

negligence but rather awarded damages against Dr. Sollenberger based upon the lack of informed consent.

NGA KOVALESKI, ADMINISTRATOR OF THE ESTATE OF BA H. KHUU DECEASED v. THE MILTON S. HERSHEY MEDICAL CENTER, STEPHEN K. POWERS, M.D. and JOSEPH A. HORTON, M.D. (1694 CV 2002)

This was a medical malpractice action. Plaintiff's decedent was treated at Hershey Medical Center for an arterial venous malformation in his brain wherein arterial blood was being pumped into his veins. Dr. Horton is a neuroradiologist specializing in the type of surgical procedures used to remedy this problem. Horton was called in as a specialist from Alabama. At the time, the patient had been under the care of Dr. Powers, a neurosurgeon. The procedure was done by Horton on April 13, 2000. There were complications and Dr. Powers was eventually called in to remove an improperly placed coil (installed by Horton). After some follow-up, decedent was released to return to work in June of 2000. He continued to have problems – he underwent an arteriogram and then a spinal tap. He was life-flighted to Thomas Jefferson where it was too late to provide additional intervention. He developed seizures and eventually slipped into a coma. He never awoke and died on February 14, 2003 in a rehabilitation facility.

Miranda McGuire is an 8 year old child with severe spinal cord dysfunction presumably as a result of a 23 month delay in the diagnosis of a spinal cord tumor. Plaintiffs allege that the pediatricians failed to properly evaluate her for the type of specialized neurological and developmental evaluation which would have led to the earlier diagnosis and treatment of her tumor. The child has significant and permanent damages to her spinal cord resulting in residual spinal chord dysfunction with neurogenic bladder, urinary tract infections, neurogenic bowel, and incontinence.
