- The Secretary serves for a one-year term and at the end of the year is eligible to be nominated for the Vice Presidency.
- Every two years, our Board and Officers are required to undergo a background check when we renew our Private Club Liquor License.
- Applicants, Directors, and Officers must be full DCBA members, with current dues timely paid.

And while you will be volunteering your service, there are certain aspirational goals and expectations that you should strive to meet. We call upon our Officers and Directors to:

- Attend all Board meetings, which generally occur on the third Thursday of each month, and attend as many Association social functions as possible.
- Attend the three membership meetings.
- Act as an ambassador for the Association by being familiar with the upcoming events and encouraging colleagues and Young Lawyers to attend.
- Assist the Board in satisfying its fiduciary obligations to the Association and to the Members.
