The innovative online program was created in partnership with the Lancaster Bar Association and capitalizes on the experiences of Central Pennsylvania's top legal experts and addresses cutting-edge legal issues such as Name, Image, and Likeness (NIL) and Artificial Intelligence.

Candidates have the option to earn three separate 21-credit undergraduate certificates or combine them with a one-credit internship to attain a 64-credit associate degree. Coursework is offered online with some synchronous components taught by Lancaster Bar Association adjunct faculty.
