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The Judges have completed the OCTOBER 2014 civil jury term. Two civil cases reached verdict during the October civil term and the summary is as follows:

RAYMOND GROTE. A MINOR BY AND THROUGH HIS PARENT AND NATURAL GUARDIAN MICHELLE SHENBERGER v. CARL A. FRANKEL, M.D., F.A.C.S AND YORK HOSPITAL (2010 CV 15124)

This was a medical malpractice action. Raymond Grote was born prematurely on April 8, 1993 at York Hospital. He was approximately 26 weeks and weighed less than two pounds. This action concerned the potential complication of premature birth known as retinopathy of prematurity ("ROP"), which can lead to blindness. While Raymond was in the York Hospital NICU, the neonatologists requested that Carl Frankel, M.D., a pediatric ophthalmologist, evaluate Raymond for ROP. After his discharge from the NICU on June 20, 1993, Dr. Frankel continued to monitor Raymond's ROP by way of outpatient visits. Raymond was found to have detached retinas, which resulted in bilateral, permanent vision loss.

The Complaint alleged that Dr. Frankel failed to properly monitor and treat Raymond's ROP, both in the NICU and later, resulting in bilateral, permanent vision loss. The Complaint also alleged that York Hospital was vicariously liable for the negligence of unnamed agents and directly liable for its own corporate negligence for violating the non-delegable duties under Thompson.

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




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
