

Bar Association Leadership Opportunities

The DCBA Nominating Committee is welcoming applications to fill open seats on our Board of Directors, as well as two Officer positions. This year we will nominate both an Association Vice President and a Secretary, as well as four Directors, to begin serving in 2022. Some things you should know:

- Directors serve for a two-year term.
- The Vice President serves for a one-year term, and at the end of the year is eligible to be nominated for the position of President-Elect.
- The Secretary serves for a one-year term, and at the end of the year is eligible to be nominated for the position of Vice President.
- Every two years, our Board and Officers are required to undergo a background check when DCBA renews our Private Club Liquor License.
- Applicants, Directors, and Officers must be full DCBA members, with current dues timely paid.

And while you will be volunteering your service, there are certain aspirational goals and expectations that you should strive to meet. We call upon our Officers and Directors to:

- Attend all Board meetings, which generally occur on the third Thursday of each month, and attend as many Association social functions as possible.
- Attend the three membership meetings.
- Act as an ambassador for the Association by being familiar with the upcoming events and encouraging colleagues and Young Lawyers to attend.
- Assist the Board in satisfying its fiduciary obligations to the Association and to the Members.
