Pursuant to Dauphin County Local Rule 1302, the Bar Association participates in the nomination process for the selection of Dauphin County Arbitrators to hear cases involving \$50,000 or less. Any attorney whose practice is located in Dauphin County may apply.

Dauphin County has an arbitration procedure whereby attorneys sit as arbitrators for a two-year term. There generally are six (6) panels with each panel sitting twice a year. The cases are heard one (1) week each month with the schedule appearing on the Court Calendar. For the 2019/2020 term, the 12 associate arbitrators were paid \$1,300.00 a week served, and the 6 panel chairs received \$1,650 a week served. Consecutive terms are not permitted.
